

For classes and groups



Option 1

MOFEP Overview Tour

Location: Current River Conservation Area (CRCA) MOFEP sites Time: Half day / flexible to meet scheduling needs

Goals: Visit even-aged and uneven -aged harvest treatments. Discuss management and MOFEP results.



Option 2 **MOFEP Overview and Field Exercise**

Location: Ellington Bunkhouse for overview presentation. Followed by field exercise on CRCA MOFEP Sites. Time: Full day including travel.

Field Exercise Options: Practice MOFEP protocols and navigation to plots. Exercise options include...

-Woody Vegetation -Botany (summer only) -Birds (Early summer preferred) Pre-Requisites: Navigation skills using compass and topo maps. Some ID skills in selected exercise helpful, required for bird option.




Students learned MOFEP vegetation protocols. Later they practiced navigating to plots and worked through the MOFEP woody vegetation protocol.

Part of the tour involves walking through a 2011 regeneration harvest that is now a dense young forest!






Missouri Valley College April 1, 2023
